Our district is continuing to move forward with the commitments made to UCS voters as part of the 2023 Safety and Success Bond Issue. Over the summer, preliminary work for the Swinehart Field improvements began by adding a four-way stop light on Utica Road at the entrance to Swinehart Field and reorienting the vehicle paths around the complex.

This spring, work will begin on a series of improvements to our athletics facilities that will enhance safety and be a visible reflection of our Utica pride.

The improvements will include a complete transformation of Swinehart Field.

While we keep the end goal in mind, we recognize this work will require some flexibility on our part. Your support is appreciated.

Q and A about Utica High School Improvements

What is the timeline for the improvements?

The improvements at Swinehart Field will begin after the spring season and are projected to conclude in the fall of 2026.

How will this impact our athletics season?

Our athletics department will be working closely with coaches to ensure that our seasons can continue without interruptions. During certain portions of the improvement process, practices or games may be staged at other available facilities. Flexibility will be important as we work to transform our facilities.

Are other field improvements planned at Utica High School?

Future athletic field improvement projects planned through the 2023 bond issue related to athletics include: synthetic turf to multi-use field, the addition of bleachers to the multi-use field, synthetic turf at softball and baseball fields and additional tennis courts.

Field improvements are being staggered with the Swinehart Field renovations and other field projects to ensure that practice and play facilities are available to student athletes.
