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INTRODUCTION

This Translation Guide for International Transcripts is intended to be used as a reference to aide administrators, counselors and staff in evaluating international transcripts of students new to the U.S. This guide provides a general comparison of international education systems and their equivalence to the U.S. System. Areas of comparisons include secondary grade levels, age equivalent, grading scales and academic courses.

When using this guide, it is important to keep in mind that the information provided may not be consistent from school to school within a country. The degree of access to education may also vary from region to region within a country. In some regions, cultural customs do not permit performing arts courses, and some academic courses may limit access by gender and ethnicity. Distinctive features like these can be found on the information page for each country and are provided to clarify inconsistencies one may see among students from the same country.

It is critical that careful judgment and discretion are used when interpreting the information presented. When obvious discrepancies are noted between the U.S and other countries, adjustments should be made that benefit the student while adhering to the Board of Education policies and practices. After consideration is given to the policies and doubt remains it is best practice to award more credit than less.

When student transcripts have been translated in another U.S. state or district, the translation of the transcript must be re-evaluated for accuracy. Many U.S. districts do not have the capacity for accurate translations. This re-evaluation process is to ensure students were awarded the appropriate credit and are not repeating courses.

UCS ENROLLMENT PROCESS

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PROCESS & RESPONSIBILITIES

Individual schools are responsible for implementing a defined process, including roles and responsibilities of staff, for the timely placement and scheduling of students.

Registration



Upon completion of registration in Enrollment Express, the student should be transferred out of the enrollment building and into the school building. Students **should not** be held in the "enrollment building" if their enrollment is complete. General education students in the State of Michigan must be younger than **20 years of age** as of **September 1st** of the current school year. *The State School Aid Act ~MCL 380.1147*

Enrollment



Upon enrollment, students are placed in the appropriate grade level based on their age. The grade level assigned may not be the appropriate grade level for the student. The grade level should be adjusted as necessary (see p. 7 *Placement*).

Translation



When a transcript or report card is received from a student or a school system in a language other than English it should be translated in a timely manner (see p.8 *Translation Process*)

Evaluation



The building is responsible for evaluating grade placement and building a graduation plan for the student. Students have access to testing out, credit recovery, 21f courses and AAPPL testing (see p. 9 *Program Considerations*).

Placement



Students are placed in the grade level that allows them to successfully complete their graduation plan. Keep in mind students must be younger than 20 years of age as of September 1st of the current school year.

CONSIDERATIONS WHEN TRANSLATING DOCUMENTS

Those translating and evaluating transcripts, report cards and other documents are recommended to do the following:

- Carefully examine all official documents for authenticity. If needed contact the sending school, embassy, Ministry of Education or other authorized agency to get further clarification
 - Other documents may include those from religious organization and non-government funded education programs
- Interview entering students and their parents/guardians to get information about prior course of study, hours of instruction, length of school year, disrupted schooling and other pertinent information helpful to the evaluation process
- Ensure that translations are provided by a qualified source

TRANSLATION PROCEDURE

All transcripts, report cards and documents being reviewed for credit must be translated.

UCS Translators are used for documents in Albanian, Arabic and Spanish:

- Email all documents to translations@uticak12.org
- An email confirmation will be sent with an expected date of completion
 - A delay can be expected if documents are found to be incomplete
- The translated documents will be returned via email

EVALUATION PROCEDURE

- The counselor uses SECTION 2 - EDUCATION LEVELS & GRADING SCALE COMPARISON PAGE, SECTION 3 - OTHER KEY INFORMATION and SECTION 4 - CURRICULUM COMPARISON to determine the credits to be awarded in each content area and the grade level placement
- The counselor assists the student in completing their Educational Development Plan (EDP)
 - A district translator or Language Line should be used to assist the student in understanding the process and coursework required towards graduation.

- Based on the student's transcript, EDP and considering the student's age the counselor creates a graduation plan (see Processes and Responsibilities- Registration p. 7) *The State School Aid Act ~MCL 380.1147*

PLACEMENT PROCEDURE

- The school counselor will work with the building office staff to update the student's grade level placement
- School counselor will input the student's Historical Course Grades in PowerSchool
- Create the students' schedule in PowerSchool

Note: When student transcripts have been translated in another U.S. state or district, the translation of the transcript must be re-evaluated for accuracy. Many U.S. districts do not have the capacity for accurate translations. This re-evaluation process is to ensure students were awarded the appropriate credit and are not repeating courses.

Testing Out - Secondary students may attempt to waive a course through testing out. Students are permitted to test one time for that course and will receive a credit on their transcript if they pass the test with a 77% or better. Testing out sessions are generally offered quarterly. Students wishing to waive a class must complete a Testing Out Form and return the completed and signed form to the counseling department.

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A PARENT'S GUIDE TO PERSONAL CURRICULUM



Focus on Transfer Students

Students transferring from out-of-state or non-public schools after completing two years of high school

Understanding the Personal Curriculum (PC) process and the options it may offer your student will help in making informed decisions about your student's educational experience and path to earning a high school diploma.

Helping All Students Succeed

All students must have a plan for the future.

Students need opportunities to investigate career pathways, to discover their interests, and to identify options for meeting their potential. This is addressed through the Educational Development Plan (EDP), which documents the student's postsecondary goals. The EDP also outlines the high school coursework the student will need to earn a high school diploma and achieve his or her postsecondary goals. A transfer student must develop an EDP in consultation with his or her school counselor upon enrollment in a Michigan public school. If a transfer student has completed at least two years of high school credit and will be unable to earn all required Michigan Merit Curriculum (MMC) credits during his or her remaining time in high school, the MMC may be modified through a PC.

Basic steps to a PC

Step 1: The parent, school personnel, student aged 18 or older, or emancipated student requests a PC.

Step 2: The PC team meets (student, parent, counselor or designee, and/or teacher(s) who currently teaches the student or has expertise in the content being modified). The PC team reviews student information, performance data, and support—including the EDP—and develops a PC. The PC team develops measurable performance goals for the modified content

The Michigan Merit Curriculum (MMC) can be modified. A PC for a transfer student who has earned at least two years of high school credit may allow the student to modify content within any required credit of the MMC except Civics. In order to determine whether or not a student has earned two years of high school credit, the district may use the student's transcript(s) from his or her previous school(s) and/or appropriate assessments to determine whether or not credit may be awarded based on demonstrated mastery of content. A transfer student who has not earned at least two years of high school credit may only be eligible for an Algebra II modification and/or additional content modifications available to all students. A modification is allowable only if it includes all MMC content that is possible for the student to complete in the remaining time in high school and enables the student to achieve his or her postsecondary goals. A modification to the MMC through use of a PC starts with a request by a parent, an emancipated student, or school personnel. The request is followed by a thorough review of the relevant information by a PC team. The PC team develops the PC plan, which must be agreed to by both the parent or legal guardian (or emancipated student) and the superintendent or his or her designee before being implemented. Upon completing the MMC, as modified by the PC, the student receives a high school diploma.

and methods to evaluate the achievement of those goals.

Step 3: The PC team writes agreement and gets sign-off from the superintendent or chief executive and the parent or legal guardian (or emancipated student).

Step 4: The PC is implemented.

Step 5: The parent or emancipated student monitors progress with each teacher of modified content area. If revisions to the PC are needed, the PC team reconvenes and makes revisions using the same process.

Step 6: The student is awarded a diploma upon completing all PC requirements.

Why would I request a Personal Curriculum?

For some students, a PC may offer the best opportunity to succeed in high school and achieve postsecondary goals. A parent may want to consider this option if his or her child has transferred from out of state or a nonpublic high school, has already earned two years of high school credit, and will be unable to earn all required MMC credits during his or her remaining time in high school.

Is my child eligible for a Personal Curriculum?

Transfer students must meet the following conditions to modify the MMC beyond what is available to all students:

The student's transcript adequately demonstrates that the student has completed the equivalent of two years of high school credit. The student has taken appropriate assessments that demonstrate that the student has completed two years of high school credit if the student has no transcript, or the transcript does not provide sufficient information to determine whether or not the student has earned two years of high school credit.

If the local district determines the student has earned two years of high school credit and cannot meet all of the MMC requirements in his or her remaining time in high school, a PC can be created to address the student's individual circumstances by modifying any MMC requirement except Civics.

What are the restrictions on a Personal Curriculum?

Even with a PC, transfer students must complete:

Focus on Enrichment

Students who are interested in earning additional credits in math, science, world languages and/or English language arts.

Focus on Algebra II

Students who demonstrate a need to reduce the Algebra II requirement.

Focus on Students with an IEP

Students with an Individualized Education Program (IEP).



A math credit in the final year of high school. The math credit must be the equivalent of Algebra I or higher if the student is enrolled in the district for one full year and has not previously earned credit in Algebra I. If the student has earned credit in Algebra I, then the credit must be earned in a math course normally taken after Algebra I (i.e., Geometry or Algebra II).

A half credit of Civics.

When would I request a Personal Curriculum?

A good time for parents to explore the PC option is at enrollment or during the creation of an EDP. A PC can be requested any time during the student's high school career.

Who can request a Personal Curriculum?

The parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of a student, or an emancipated student may request a PC. School personnel may also request a PC or recommend that students and parents consider the PC option.

Interested parents must contact the high school counselor or principal to begin the process. A planning meeting may be scheduled when the school receives a formal request. The process will involve an agreement between the parent, student, and the district superintendent or designee.

Districts MUST offer the PC option and respond to PC requests but are NOT required to approve all PC requests.

SEAL OF GLOBAL LANGUAGE

MICHIGAN SEAL OF BILITERACY

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The Utica Community Schools will be offering a seal of global language upon graduation for students completing the required criteria. The seal of global language is a recognition given by Utica Community Schools to students who have attained proficiency in English and one or more other world languages by high school graduation. Global language proficiency is defined as having the ability to read, write, speak and listen in more than one language. This recognition becomes part of the high school transcript and diploma. The seal demonstrates a student's readiness for college and career, it can be evidence of skills to future employers, and it recognizes a student's engagement as a global citizen. Utica Community Schools embraces an expectation that our students attain a high level of proficiency in speaking, reading, listening and writing in one or more languages in addition to English. All students are eligible to attain the Seal of Global language based on evidence of achieving the designated level of language proficiency in English plus one or more other languages during their high school years.

Option 1: UCS World Language Program: French, German, Japanese or Spanish

Criteria:

1. Completion of a four-year HS course in one world language with an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher
2. Score 480 or above on the Evidence - Based Reading and Writing portion of state exam (MME) in grade 11
3. Score proficient on one of the following assessments: Advanced Placement, IB exam, AAPPL exam or OPI & WPT exam (See Below)

3. Score proficient on one of the following assessments: Advanced Placement, IB exam, AAPPL exam or OPI & WPT exam (See Below)

6210 POLICY – Online/Digital Learning/Virtual Course Credit.

Online/digital learning/virtual courses are permitted for students in grades 6-12. Credit for online/digital learning/virtual course work will not be granted for the purpose of early graduation.

6220 POLICY – Personal Curriculum.

The Board of Education is dedicated to preparing all its students for post-secondary education. We recognize students have differing career goals, educational abilities, and backgrounds. Therefore, the Board will allow a modification of certain requirements of the Michigan Merit Curriculum through a Personal Curriculum, as permitted by state law and Michigan Department of Education guidelines.

6225 POLICY – Dual Enrollment.

The Board of Education is committed to providing students opportunities for post-secondary education. Therefore, students in grades 9 through 12 may participate in dual enrollment, as applicable under the law, to take approved courses at Michigan public or private colleges, while completing high school graduation requirements. High school graduation credits and/or college credits may be awarded for academic courses taken within accredited post-secondary institutions if the district requirements are met. The Superintendent/designee shall develop the Rules and Regulations for the implementation of this policy in accordance with the law. 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




