Dear Eisenhower High School Students and Parents:

For the spring of 2025, eleventh graders will take the Michigan Merit Examination (MME). The MME consists of the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) as the state administered college assessment and the ACT WorkKeys for College and Career readiness. Additionally, the Michigan Student Test of Educational Progress (M-STEP) assesses science and social studies. The tenth-grade students will be given the Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test (PSAT) 10 assessment.

To ensure all tenth and eleventh grade students have every opportunity to be successful on their particular assessment(s), the following testing schedule will be implemented for Wednesday, April 19, 2025, Thursday, April 10, 2025, and Wednesday, April 16, 2025.


