

Contract will then occur between student and Mr. May to recover credit. Failure to meet contract will result in a failing grade (F).

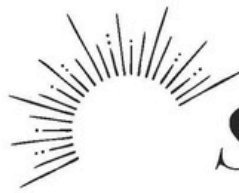

10 Days of SAT Practice



The secret to success

This was designed to be a helpful tool to assist students start their "At-home" SAT Test Prep Journey.

Although it is optional, we are hoping you find it helpful and achievable.

Day 1: Find the Bluebook App on your desktop of your school laptop. If you do not have it, [Download Bluebook™](#). You will need it for Days 3-10

Day 2: Scan the QR Code for Practice Quick Start Guide and review it. You will need it for Day 3!



Day 3: In Bluebook, use your CollegeBoard login or the Test Ticket that was provided to login. Under Practice and Prepare, select Full Length Practice. Choose SAT for the Test Type and select a practice test of your choice. **Complete Reading and Writing Module 1 (32 mins)**

Day 4: Using the same test from Day 3, complete **Reading and Writing Module 2 (32 mins)**

Day 5: Using the same test from Day 3, complete **Math Module 1 (35 mins)**

Day 6: Using the same test from Day 3, complete **Math Module 2 (35 mins)**

Day 7: Using the same login info, go to My Practice at mypractice.collegeboard.org to view their score results and your practice exam questions, answers, and explanations

Day 8: Using your results set new SAT goals and make an individual plan. Your plan may include repeating Day 3-6 with another Practice Test or working through "My Practice" which is designed for you.

Day 9: Visit the Official Digital SAT Prep on Khan Academy® provides targeted prep for students by identifying specific goals and giving them practice questions with full explanations at <https://www.khanacademy.org/digital-sat>

Day 10: Have a positive attitude, believe in yourself, and have a growth mindset.




