Dear Eisenhower High School Students and Parents:

For the spring of 2025, eleventh graders will take the Michigan Merit Examination (MME). The MME consists of the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) as the state administered college assessment and the ACT WorkKeys for College and Career readiness. Additionally, the Michigan Student Test of Educational Progress (M-STEP) assesses science and social studies. The tenth-grade students will be given the Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test (PSAT) 10 assessment.

To ensure all tenth and eleventh grade students have every opportunity to be successful on their particular assessment(s), the following testing schedule will be implemented for Wednesday, April 9, 2025, Thursday, April 10, 2025, and Wednesday, April 16, 2025.

Wednesday, April 9, 2025 – M-STEP

7:45 a.m. – 10:45 a.m. (Standard Testing Time)

- 10th grade students will remain home and participate in asynchronous work for hours 1 – 6.
- 11th grade students will report to their home school for a.m. testing
- 11th grade students will be released at 10:45 a.m. and will participate in asynchronous work for hours 4,5,6.
- 12th grade students remain home and will participate in asynchronous work for hours 1,2,3 and will report to their home schools at 10:45 a.m. to attend in-person classes for hours 4,5,6. (no transportation will be provided)
- LCCE students will report to their home school for a.m. testing
- LCCE students will be released at 10:45 a.m. and will participate in asynchronous work for hours 4,5,6.
- Shared-time programs are cancelled

Thursday, April 10, 2025 – PSAT 10 and WorkKeys

7:45 a.m. – 10:45 a.m. (Standard Testing Time)

- 10th and 11th grade students will report to their home school for a.m. testing and will remain at their home school and attend in-person classes for hours 4,5,6.
- 12th grade students remain home and will participate in asynchronous work for hours 1,2,3 and will report to their home schools at 10:45 a.m. to attend in-person classes for hours 4,5,6 (no transportation will be provided)
- LCCE students will report to their home school for a.m. testing and will remain at their home school and attend in-person classes for hours 4,5,6.
- Shared-time programs are cancelled

Wednesday, April 16, 2025 – SAT

7:45 a.m. – 10:45 a.m. (Standard Testing Time)

- 10th grade students will remain home and participate in asynchronous work for hours 1 – 6.
- 11th grade students will report to their home school for a.m. testing
- 11th grade students will be released at 10:45 a.m. and will participate in asynchronous work for hours 4,5,6.
- 12th grade students remain home and will participate in asynchronous work for hours 1 – 6.
- LCCE students remain home and will participate in asynchronous work for hours 1 – 6.
- Shared-time programs are cancelled

This schedule is an additional measure to provide our students with every opportunity for success. Additionally, it ensures that every student's time in school is time well spent. More details will be shared with students who are participating in remote learning on these testing days.

Additionally, students participating in PSAT 10, and SAT online assessments will be prompted to participate in the [College Board Connections program and Big Future program](#). Students will be instructed to opt out of these programs, unless the attached form is returned to your students' first hour teacher by March 21, 2025.



The Michigan DNR Conservation Officer Cadet Academy, July 6-11, 2025 is a free career exploration opportunity for individuals who are interested in a career as a CO.

Cadets will receive training and real-life experience while lodging in cabins at the DNR's Ralph A. MacMullan Conference Center, located on Higgins Lake in Roscommon. COs will lead cadets through morning physical training, then follow a daily agenda similar to the CO Training Academy, covering a number of subjects, including:

- Conservation law
- Hunting regulations and enforcement
- Marine safety
- Water safety
- Off-road vehicle operation
- Search and rescue
- Survival tactics
- First aid

Eligibility

All applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered:

- 18-21 years of age.
- Must be a senior in high school or enrolled in college, trade school, or military with a GPA of 2.7 or higher (most recent transcript and proof of current enrollment are required).
- Interested in pursuing a career in law enforcement or natural resources.
- Have no felony or misdemeanor convictions within the past three years.
- Must be willing to lodge overnight at the RAM Center and participate in all activities, which will be directly supervised by conservation officers.
- Successfully complete and submit all of the required documents and forms.

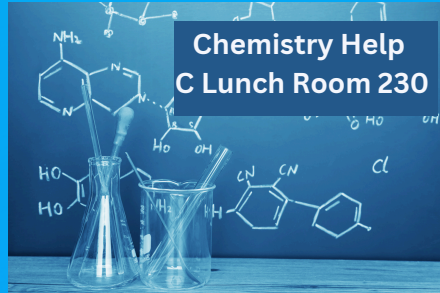

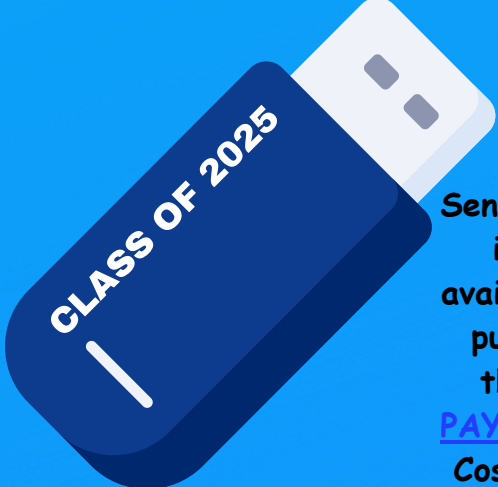
