SUN Bucks is the new name for the Summer EBT grocery benefit. Eligible families will receive \$120 per child to purchase groceries over the summer. Once your family is enrolled, SUN Bucks will be automatically added to your SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program) account or you will be issued a separate EBT (Electronic Benefit Transfer) card.

Families will be automatically enrolled in SUN Bucks if they are already enrolled in SNAP, TANF (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families.)

The Education Benefit Form (EBF) will not count towards this you will need to enroll separately for SUN Bucks.

Apply by April 15, 2025 to be eligible for the first issuance of benefits in May 2025. Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis until August 31, 2025.



General description: The Ike Community Market is a place where everyone of all ages can shop or sell items. Just think of it as a garage sale from our community! It will take place on May 31st from 8 a.m. - 1 p.m. in Eisenhower High School's front parking lot. Our cleanup crew will be available until 2 p.m., which is the time the event concludes (when donation trucks will be leaving). If you'd like to sell items from your business or just want to get rid of extra items lying around your house, you can purchase a parking spot. You'll be claiming two parking spaces, one of the parking spaces will be for your car and the other will be to sell your items, for \$45. If you purchase a spot, you must be all set up by the start time, 8 a.m. We will start allowing vendors in the parking lot at 7 a.m. and no earlier to set up. We will have table rental available for \$10 per table and they must all be returned before you leave. 
