What is the timeline for the improvements? The improvements at Swinehart Field will begin this winter and are projected to conclude in the fall of 2026.

How will this impact our athletics season? Spring 2025 sports will continue at Swinehart. Following this season, our athletics department will be working closely with coaches to ensure that facilities are available to meet the needs of our student athletes.
