GRADING SYSTEM AND GPA

A = 4.0 Scale

A to D- = Passing Grade (100-60%)

F = Failure (lower than 60%)

NC = No Credit

CR = Credit

Grading is based on a 12-point scale (A=12).

Results are equated to a 4.0 scale by division. AP courses are weighted, adding an additional 0.5 points to the traditional scale, which could result in a GPA being higher than 4.0. All classes taken prior to 9th grade are awarded CR if applicable. All students are ranked and have a weighted GPA.
