

5535 POLICY - Student Money-Raising Activities and Fee Charges

The district will permit students to engage in money-raising activities and fee charges to support approved student activities. The number of activities approved should be held to a minimum. All money raised by such activities will be expended for activities or materials which shall benefit the student body.

All monies collected in the name of the Utica Community Schools must be promptly deposited in the Trust and Agency Fund. All expenditures of these funds must be made through the Trust and Agency Fund. Deviations from this stipulation will only be allowed after written authorization from the Office of Business Affairs.



5535 RULES AND REGULATIONS - Student Fund-Raising Activities

All schools within the district will be permitted to have students engage in fund-raising activities. All such activities must be approved by the school principal. All money raised by such activities will be expended for activities or materials which shall benefit the student body.

Guidelines:

- I. The purpose for sponsoring the activity must be beneficial to the student body.
- II. The number of activities held by any one school shall be held to a minimum.
- III. Activities which promote door-to-door soliciting on the part of the student shall be discouraged.

All expenditures of these funds must be made through the Trust and Agency Fund. Deviations from this stipulation will only be allowed after written authorization from the Office of Business Affairs.
