
5th and 6th Grade Suggested Supply List \circ 1-accordion folder o 1- plastic durable folder o 4 spirals- green, yellow, blue, and red • Writing journal 1 graph paper spiral (must be wire bound or it will fall apart) o 3 jars of rubber cement 4 red checking pens Sharpened Pencils • Colored pencils (at least a 24 pack) • Scissors (adult sized) • 4 highlighters (different colors) \circ Pad of Post-It notes • Clipboard (recommended, but not necessary) • Earbud headphones *with* case to keep them in \circ 1 inch binder with poly-cover to slide a cover in (We will use this for our data binder) • 5 tabbed dividers (To separate the sections of our data binder) • Basic calculator (6th grade only!) (Recommended) \bigcirc 1-Clorox wipes \odot 2-Kleenex boxes \odot 1-Bottle of hand soap

* We find that wire bound spiral notebooks work best and stand up to classroom use. Perforated paged and bound notebooks fall apart easily.

We use scrapbook paper for our 6th grade memory books and other projects. It would be useful if you could donate some *scrapbook paper*.

• Also, we are highly recommending buying a *few rolls of washi* tape to use for memory and poetry book.
