## JANUARY SCHOLARSHIP NEWSLETTER

DEADLINES BETWEEN: January 31, 2026 & March 2, 2026

### 1) **National Eagle Scout Association Scholarships** - \$50,000 - 32 Awards (Deadline: January 31, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a senior in high school or a freshman, sophomore, or junior in a college undergraduate program.
- B) Be a member of the National Eagle Scout Association.

### 2) **SAA Native American Scholarships** - \$10,000 - 4 Awards (Deadline: January 31, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be planning to enroll in archaeology or museum studies.
- B) Be Native American, Alaska Native, or Native Hawaiian.

**4) Society of Manufacturing Engineers Scholarship - \$20,000 - 60 Awards (Deadline: Feb 1, 2026)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a graduating high school senior, current undergraduate or graduate student who will be enrolling as a part-time or full-time undergraduate or graduate student.

B) Have a minimum GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.

**5) John & Tamara Lundgren Scholars Program - \$8,000 - 20 Awards (Deadline: February 6, 2026)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Plan to enroll in fulltime undergraduate studies at one of the 17 accredited PGA Golf Management Universities pursuing a PGA Golf Management degree.

B) Be a high school senior or current postsecondary undergraduate student.

**6) Davidson Fellows Scholarships - \$100,000 - 20 Awards (Deadline: February 11, 2026)**

**8) National Italian American Foundation Scholarships - \$12,000 - 200 Awards (Deadline: March 1, 2026)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Have at least one ancestor who has immigrated from Italy.
- B) Be enrolled in a US-accredited institution on a full-time basis for the Fall 2026 semester.

**12) Children of Warriors National Scholarship - \$5,000 - 15 Awards (Deadline: March 1, 2026)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a daughter, son, grandson, granddaughter, great-granddaughter, great-grandson of a veteran who served in the Armed Forces.

B) Excel in academics at school and participate in volunteer activities outside of school.
