You can access your student's schedule in PowerSchool.

If you haven't completed your district REQUIRED forms, please take a moment to do this now. On a computer, log into your PARENT Powerschool account and click "Quick Links", then "Forms". Click on REQUIRED TO COMPLETE EACH YEAR in Powerschool. Click SUBMIT at the bottom when you have completed and electronically signed this online form. **This must be done prior to Titan Days.**

If you have selected "I have changes..." Click on 1. Update Student Address, 2 Update Student Contacts, or 3 Update Health Information. **If there are no changes, please do not hit submit on these pages.**

Please note: If you make any changes to the "Update Student Address" page, please be sure to update the "Update Student Contacts: Legal Guardians and Emergency Contacts" page as well.

If your student's name is spelled incorrectly in Powerschool, please email Caren.King@uticak12.org to get it corrected.

TECHNOLOGY INSURANCE - There is still time to purchase your annual laptop insurance for accidents that cause damage to the UCS school issued device. HOW TO APPLY

1. Student visits apply.drdfs.org on or after September 16th, 2024.
2. Student completes the application and clicks "submit" prior to October 24, 2024 at 11:59 P.M.
3. Once the application is submitted, the student receives an email confirmation of the submission.
4. The parent/guardian receives an email asking for their signature on release forms.
- 5 The parent/guardian clicks the link in the email to sign the release forms, completes the application with their signatures and clicks "submit." Parent/guardian forms must also be completed by 11:59 P.M. on October 24, 2024.
6. Completed applications will be reviewed and students will be notified by November 26, 2024 of their admission to the program.

MEDICATION - If your student requires medication to be taken during the school day, please bring in the completed UCS medical forms and their medication Monday through Friday from 8:00 – 2:30. ATTENDANCE - 586-797-1999 - **A parent must call the attendance line at 586-797-1999** if your student will be absent, tardy or will have an early dismissal. The attendance desk will enter the attendance in Powerschool by the end of the school day. For early dismissals, the student will be written an early dismissal pass that they can pick up from the attendance desk. **DO NOT** call the main office for attendance.

PARKING PERMITS - Mrs. Bartold is accepting parking permit applications from seniors. The permits are \$50. You can find the Parking Permit Application on the Stevenson website: Stevenson High School under Parent Quick Links. Please print it and bring copies of all required documents. *Junior parking permits will be available for purchase starting September 9 and will be first come, first served, based on availability and eligibility. PARKING is NOT allowed by students and/or parents in the Court House/City Center parking lot or along Dodge Park Road. Dropping off students in this area is also not allowed.

We will continue the Attendance Program that began at the end of last school year. Parking permits are dependent on attendance. Students who have accumulated **5 or more tardies and/or Unexcused absences**, will not receive their parking permit for the **1st five weeks of the school year (October 1st 2024)**. At that point, with responsible attendance, parking will be reevaluated for the school year. In addition, outstanding fees must be paid in full to be eligible for a parking permit. Reminder that students are expected to be in school on time. Parking Permits may be suspended for the following reasons:

- ❖ Excessive unexcused absences or tardies
- ❖ Careless or reckless driving
- ❖ Persistent disciplinary issues

PARKING is NOT allowed by students and/or parents in the Court House/City Center parking lot. Dropping off students in this area is also not allowed.

Student Dress Code Students must adhere to the guidelines outlined in the student handbook. • Indecent, tattered, or unsafe dress or footwear, or attire that calls undue attention to the wearer or has lettering or symbols that are disrespectful or derogatory are not allowed. • Beach wear, low-cut tops, tank tops, sleeveless tops, muscle shirts, see-through clothing, short skirts or shorts, pajamas, tight clothing without proper coverage and clothing exposing the shoulders or mid-section are not allowed. • Students should not wear clothing with inappropriate advertising like Playboy shirts or similar items. • Hats are not allowed in school unless explicit permission for a medical or religious reason is reached. • Knee length shorts and skirts are acceptable. Shoes must be worn. • Outerwear, such as coats and hats, is not to be worn in school. • Clothing that promotes illegal substances or drugs, illegal activities, violence, tobacco, or alcohol is prohibited. • Clothing or head coverings worn as group identifiers that promote a disruptive school climate are prohibited. • Clothing consistent with religious or cultural beliefs is acceptable. • Jewelry and accessories that may be deemed dangerous are prohibited.

- Thanks to the state of Michigan for putting Michigan School Meals in the budget, UCS students will receive free breakfast and lunch throughout the 2024-25 school year.

PARKING ON DODGE PARK UPDATE - We have been working with the City of Sterling Heights to improve the safety for students who are crossing Dodge Park to get to and from school. Over the past couple of years, we have had several serious incidents that have reinforced the need to take additional steps to keep our students safe.

We are pleased that a flashing crosswalk sign (called "Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons") is being installed that will alert drivers that they are approaching a pedestrian crossing.

The second is that the Dodge Park Road cut out in front of our school will no longer be available for families who are waiting for their students at the end of the day or dropping them off in the morning. The city has already put in stripes to indicate that cars may not park in the area.

Your support is appreciated for these improvements. It is important that we are all doing our part to ensure the safety of our Titans.

FINES & FEES - Please check your student's PowerSchool account 'Dashboard' for Outstanding fees. Outstanding fees should be paid immediately. ALL outstanding fees/obligations must be cleared with Mrs. Darroch, Bookkeeper.

IMPORTANT: Students with outstanding fees/obligations cannot purchase 2024-2025 Parking Permits or participate in Athletics and other extra-curricular activities, including August Titan Days and Homecoming until all fees/obligations are cleared.

School Safety and Security

School ID Badges Ensuring safety and security for all students and staff is a priority each day. In addition to enhancing security, the wearing of ID badges provides a professional setting and promotes College and Career Readiness for all students.

Wearing of IDs is required as part of many workplace environments, as well as on many college and university campuses. One student ID and lanyard will be provided to every student at no cost.

The benefits and reasons for students wearing a current student ID card are:

- To be in class
- To purchase lunch
- To borrow library books and textbooks
- To obtain early dismissal
- To allow movement during school, going to and from restrooms, etc.
- To be on campus before or after school
- To participate in school activities, assemblies, dances, etc. at school.

Student ID Guidelines

A student's ID card authorizes him/her to be on the school campus. EVERY student must wear his or her student ID card while on school grounds. It is crucial that the school staff can identify everyone on campus. The identification of staff and students is a safety issue and will not be compromised. Student IDs may be left in the student's assigned locker overnight to ensure the student ID is not left at home. The following guidelines must be adhered to when wearing student ID cards:

1. Student ID cards must always be worn and visible (i.e., not kept in a purse, pocket, or backpack).
2. The student ID card must be presented to any school staff member or person of authority upon request.
3. The front and back of the student ID card cannot be altered (i.e., no markings, other photos, etc.). Defacing or altering the student ID is prohibited.
4. Wearing another student's ID card is prohibited.
5. Lost, stolen, altered, damaged and/or defaced student ID cards must be replaced immediately.

Students who fail to adhere to the above guidelines are subject to a lunch detention (or after school detention) and a replacement fee of \$5.00 to replace a lost ID badge. Students can purchase a new lanyard from the school or purchase one on their own. Tear away lanyards are recommended. Students who are insubordinate or persistently disobedient are subject to further school consequences.

Student Dress Code

Students must adhere to the guidelines outlined in the student handbook.

Attendance Policy

Another important reminder is to take time with your student to review the UCS High School Credit Review Rules and Procedures. In short, it starts by saying that a student has a responsibility to attend, be on time and prepared for each scheduled class. When a student nears or is at 10 absences (any combination of absences or tardies) they will meet with their Associate Principal and parents will be notified. At 11 absences the student will enter Credit Review and can restore those credits by making up the lost time for the classes via a contract made with their associate principal. This cannot be recovered short of testing out, taking the class via scheduling, credit recovery or summer school. Please take the time to read and discuss this with your students, and make sure they understand.

Attendance and Early Dismissal Procedures

Please call **586-797-1999** and follow the prompts:

1 = Early Dismissals 2 = Late Arrival 3 = All Day Absences

Please do not call the main office for attendance. When an Early Dismissal is necessary, a PARENT MUST call in the dismissal before the student leaves. Otherwise, your student will be marked unexcused. Also, your student must check in with the Main Office before they leave campus to ensure their safety. PowerSchool is now generating automated phone calls to parents informing them of any absences for their students daily. Please use your Parent Portal to view your student's attendance.

If you have any concerns, email the individual teacher directly through the staff tab of the school's website or through the PowerSchool. If a correction is warranted, the teacher will request one. Our goal is to have call-ins recorded before the office closes for the day. However, if you have any questions regarding your student's attendance, please wait 24 hours to ensure that all records are complete and up to date.
